*"The range of topics, resources and facilities were very impressive."*


After half term, starting on Monday 4 November, there are **internal examinations** for **Y8** and **Y10** pupils, as well as **Y11** mock GCSE examinations in English (Thursday 7 November) and mathematics (Monday 4 and Thursday 7 November). Individualised exam timetables will be issued to students and will be available on the intranet before half term. I have, however, also attached a general timetable to this letter.

Grayscroft have advised us of a road closure that will be in place between **Mablethorpe and Sutton on Sea** affecting several school services, taking effect **after** the October term break. We attach timetables and maps for all of the affected services. Grayscroft will be taking a longer route between Mablethorpe and Sutton on Sea: the first few pickups will be at earlier times, although the majority of the pickups will be at normal time, causing least disruption. **No pickups or drop offs** will be made between Park Road in Sutton on Sea and Seaholme Road in Mablethorpe.
