Brief Details of the School

Queen Elizabeth's is a Selective Academy, currently having 569 pupils (including 145 in the sixth form) on roll. We converted to Academy status in October 2010.

The school is a very friendly and caring community in which pupils are known and valued individually. The atmosphere is calm, happy and purposeful; standards of attainment, behaviour and dress are high.

Academic results are high at Queen Elizabeth's and we are proud of our reputation as one of the top Grammar schools in Lincolnshire.

We aim to provide a broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum, with our Specialist status being Business and Enterprise.

The Computer Science department at Queen Elizabeth's Grammar

The aim of the Computer Science department is to enable the students to become competent users of equipment as well as to develop them into computational and logical thinkers.

We currently have 5 members of the department 4 of whom also contribute to the maintenance of the network and our primary school networks. This is an exciting time to join a well-resourced and forward-thinking department.

The academy has more than 250 PCs running Windows 7/10 and over 70 Netbooks/Laptops with a nearly-full wireless site. Our server operating system is Windows Server 2008/2012 and we make good use of virtualisation. All teaching rooms have projectors and many have Smartboard interactive whiteboards.

We also manage four local primary schools' networks and we can remotely manage many facilities within their schools.

We have a range of software available but the main packages used by the school are Microsoft Office 2016, Adobe Design Premium Suite CS4, Visual Studio, Smart Notebook and Recorder.

We have our own student-run radio station which is housed within the Computer Science department. Our VLE is bespoke and all departments make use of the tools on offer. We have also developed our own App, QEGS Anywhere, which is used by both pupils and their parents.

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
